Locally, Dr. Ponce is the **Medical Director of The Weight Loss Center of Chattanooga, PLLC** (www.weightlosschatt.com), the region's only independent comprehensive center offering both medical and surgical therapies for obesity. His team integrates bariatric medicine, surgery, nutrition, psychology, and exercise support to deliver long-term, multidisciplinary care.

"I am deeply honored to serve as President-Elect of IFSO and to continue the mission of improving access, quality, and outcomes in obesity treatment worldwide," said Dr. Ponce. "This election reflects not only my commitment, but also the extraordinary work being done in Chattanooga and across the globe to recognize obesity as the chronic disease it is and to expand effective therapies for patients."

In his role as President-Elect, Dr. Ponce will collaborate with immediate IFSO Past-President Ricardo Cohen of São Paulo, Brazil and incoming President Khaled Gawdat of Cairo, Egypt to expand international collaboration and improve access to high-quality obesity and metabolic disease care.
